

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Holding tanks must be pumped out prior to haul. The Marion Town Dock provides a pump-out station.
2. All bottom preparing, sanding, stripping, and painting in yard will be performed by A and J Boat Corp.
3. There will be no access to all boats stored except during normal business hours. There will be no painting, varnishing, sanding, etc... to boats that are stored inside any building. Boat owners are not allowed to hire any outside contractors to work on boats in our yard, dock, or buildings. Independent contractors, brokers, service organizations or outside individuals will not be allowed to perform work or enter upon the yard, dock, or building of A and J Boat Corp. Contractors must first file a certificate of insurance for workers compensation and liability with A and J Boat Corp.
4. Boat owners and visitors must check in prior to working on their boats. All work done by boat owners shall be during operation hours, unless there is an emergency. Area around your boat must be kept clean and hazard free. Clean up of excess litter will be billed to your account. At no time shall 110v lines be left unplugged and unattended. Space heaters, heat guns, torches, or open flames are prohibited. All work done by boat owner must be in compliance with all local, state, federal, and EPA regulations. Only non-toxic antifreeze is allowed. The owner agrees NOT to hold A and J Boat Corp. liable for any/all losses resulting from violation from these provisions.
5. Shrink wrapping is done by A and J Boat Corp. Canvas covers allowed only if approved by A and J Boat Corp. There will be no tarps. Nothing will be tied to boat stands. Boat owners are not allowed to place, move, or adjust stands or blocks. If attention is needed, please notify one of our yard employees.
6. It is understood and agreed that in an event of the boat, its contents, and/or equipment if lost or damaged through theft, fire, vandalism, or inclement weather that A and J Boat Corp. shall not be held liable unless the damages is caused by negligence of A and J Boat Corp., its agents or employees.
7. Owner of boats in storage or on the premises at A and J Boat Corp. agrees to keep their own insurance on their boats for all losses. A copy of your active policy must be included with your storage contract. If insurance requirements are not in effect you will be told to remove your boat from the premises at your expense. A and J Boat Corp. recommends that all boats owners remove electronics, outboard motors, and gear from their boats. A and J Boat Corp. does not provide insurance for boats in storage on the premises.
8. Work will be billed upon completion. Rates are based on time and materials unless otherwise quoted. Interest charges and service fees will apply to unpaid balances after 30 days.
9. When boats are determined to need immediate attention (collapsed covers, accumulated water, broken hatches, etc...) A and J Boat Corp. will take steps to fix problems and bill the owners account.
10. No fueling of boats on premises.
11. Pressure washing must be done by A and J Boat Corp.
12. Hauling and launching must be given at least 7 days notice.
13. All sails must be removed prior to haul.
14. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times
15. Pets must be on a leash and owners shall be responsible for all actions and clean up.
